16 Nov., 1929 - 10 May, 1930.

On Ocean Island undergoing training as an administrative officer in the Resident Commissioner's and Treasury, Customs and Postal Departments. Only incidental contacts with Banabans.

11 March - 1 July, 1931.

As Census Officer, Gilbert and Ellice Islands, took first detailed census of Banaban population.

5 Oct., 1931 - 7 March, 1932.

As Native Lands Commissioner made lands settlement of Ocean Island, registering 2,479 lands and hearing 97 ownership and boundary disputes.

11 Nov., 1932 - 5 Feb., 1933.

Administrative Officer, Ocean Island. Main contacts were with local Island Government on legal and administrative matters. Principal duties were in Secretariat as Assistant Secretary to Government.

15 March, 1933 - 14 June, 1933.

Acting Secretary to Government and Administrative Officer, Ocean Island (conjoint). Duties as above.

9 Sept., 1938 - 15 Nov., 1938.
Administrative Officer (conjoint).

Nov. and Dec., 1945.

Resident Commissioner, Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony. Contacts with Banabans collected at Bairiki, Tarawa Island, prior to embarkation for Rabi Island.

27 - 29 June, 1946.

Visited Rabi Island with Mr P.D. Macdonald to investigate Banaban complaints against Major D.G. Kennedy.

7 - 13 May, 1947.

Visited Rabi Island with Mr P.D. Macdonald to ascertain wishes of Banabans as to returning to Ocean Island or remaining on Rabi Island.
