They were the offspring of Kaiteng. These five people travelled with the
waka in the bottom of the sea from Samoa. While they were coming they
were seen by Tabuaniki to Katumara one of the Rangi Ione. He ate all
of them, being a cannibal, except Te Ione and Matensang. Matensang lay with
Te Ione while the others were being eaten and then they separated, Matensang
going to Tarawa and Te Ione to Ben. After the rest had been eaten
Te Ione gave voice to the lament, "A ra kua kua kawai ke a ra
haua ngutu narahe na mangi a ra wawabunga wawakara. Hui narahe,
itua narahe a ra rana te ike mai rana, rana Tarawa, i rana, Te
Kaiteng, Rainisaki, Roro ra Te Ione. E kaitiaki Te Ione i rana te
kanga te Ngungu. E rana i rana Ben." Te Ione landed at
Anonastara in the south of Ben lagoon (just south of Naha village in the small
lagoon). He named a daughter of Rangin Tonati. When made
Ben after Samoa and Tabuaniki and Rangin Tonati grew up a Ben itself.
