Author of *Essays in probability and statistics* (1962), etc.
- Behrens, Walter U. (1902–62). Research worker, Institute for Field and Plant Production, University of Königsberg, 1927–31, Institute for Agricultural Chemistry and Bacteriology, University of Berlin, 1932–5, and Agricultural Research Station, Kali-Chemie AG, Hannover, 1935–62. Author of *Mathematische Methoden für Versuchsansteller* (1933).
- Bliss, Chester I. (1899–1979). Entomologist, US Department of Agriculture, 1926–33. Research worker in the Galton Laboratory, 1933–5, and Institute for Plant Protection, Leningrad, USSR, 1936–7. Biometrician, Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station, 1938–71. Author of *Statistics in biology* (1967).
- Box, George E.P., FRS (1919–). Statistician, Imperial Chemical Industries Ltd., 1948–56. Professor of Statistics, University of Wisconsin, 1960–. Co-author (with G.C. Tiao) of *Bayesian inference in statistical analysis*, (1973) etc.
- Buckland, William R. (1914–). Head, Statistical Advisory Service, London Transport Executive, 1946–60. Manager, Statistical Advisory Service, The Economist Intelligence Unit, London, 1960–79. Visiting Lecturer and then Professor in Management Sciences, Royal Holloway College London, 1970–81. Co-author (with M.G. Kendall) of *A dictionary of statistical terms* (1955).
- Buros, Oscar K. (1905–78). Assistant Professor and then Professor of Education, Rutgers University, New Brunswick, 1932–65.

Co-author with G.M. Cox of *Experimental designs* (1957).
- Corbière, Henri L.G. (1888–1980). Poet and scientific writer.
- Cornish, E. Alfred (1909–73). Australian research worker in the Galton Laboratory, 1937–8. Chief, CSIRO Division of Mathematical Statistics, 1954–73. Professor of Mathematical Statistics, University of Adelaide, 1960–4. Co-author with Fisher of *CP* 148 and 281.
- Daniels, Henry E., FRS (1912–). Statistician, Wool Industries Research Association, 1935–47. Lecturer in Mathematics, University of Cambridge, 1947–57. Professor of Mathematical Statistics, University of Birmingham, 1957–78.
- Darmois, Georges (1888–1960). Director of the Institute of Statistics, University of Paris, 1945–60. Author of *Statistique mathématique* (1928), etc.
- Deming, W. Edwards (1900–). Physicist, US Department of Agriculture, 1927–39. Professor of Statistics, New York University, 1946–76. Author of *Statistical adjustment of data* (1943).
- Dufrénoy, H. Jean (1894–1972). Director, Plant Pathology Station, Pont-de-la-Maye, France, 1936.
- Edelstam, Carl. A Swedish zoologist, 1948.
- Eisenhart, Churchill (1913–). Statistician, University of Wisconsin Experiment Station, 1937–47, Statistical Research Group, Columbia University, 1944–5, and US National Bureau of Standards, 1946–83.
- Fieller, Edgar C. (1907–60). Mathematical Assistant to Karl Pearson and then Lecturer in Statistics, University College London, 1929–34. Head of Statistics Section, National Physical Laboratory, 1946–52, and Ministry of Supply, 1952–60. A Vice-president of the Royal Statistical Society during Fisher's Presidency, 1952–4.
- Finney, David J., FRS (1917–). Member of Statistical Department at Rothamsted, 1939–45. Reader and then Professor of Statistics, University of Aberdeen, 1954–66. Professor of Statistics, University of Edinburgh, 1966–84. Director, Agricultural Research Council Unit of Statistics, 1954–84. Author of *Statistical method in biological assay* (1952), etc.
- Fisher, Arne (1886–1944). Actuary, Western Union Telegraph Company, USA, 1920–44. Author of *The mathematical theory of probabilities* (1915).
- Fraser, Donald A.S. (1925–). Assistant Professor and then Professor of Statistics, University of Toronto, 1949–. Author of *The structure of inference* (1968), etc.

- Fréchet, Maurice (1878–1973). Professor, Institut Henri Poincaré, University of Paris, 1929–49. Author of *Généralités sur les probabilités: éléments aléatoires* (1935), etc.
- Frisch, Ragnar (1895–1973). Professor and Director of Research, Economic Institute, University of Oslo, Norway, 1931–71.
- Goossens, Leon (1890–1978). An engineer concerned with spinning and the textile industry, Societe Anonyme de la Lys, Gand, Belgium, 1923–57.
- Grant, Robert (1878–1959). A partner in the publishing firm Oliver and Boyd Ltd., Edinburgh, 1898–1928, and director 1929–53.

- Greenwood, Major, FRS (1880–1949). Professor of Epidemiology and Vital Statistics, London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, 1928–45.
- Harrod, Sir Roy F., FBA (1900–78). Nuffield Reader in Economics, University of Oxford, 1952–67. Author of *The foundations of inductive logic* (1956), etc.
- Heckstall-Smith, Hugh W. (1896–1973). Headmaster, Chippenham Grammar School, Wiltshire, 1935–9. Author of *Doubtful schoolmaster*, (1962), etc.
- Hick, William E. (1912–74). Reader in Experimental Psychology, University of Cambridge, 1954–66.

- Irwin, J. Oscar (1898–1982). Member of Statistical Department at Rothamsted, 1928–31, and of scientific staff of Medical Research Council at London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, 1931–65.
- James, Alan T. (1924–). Visiting Lecturer and then Associate Professor of Mathematics, 1958–63, and Professor of Mathematical Statistics, 1963–5, Yale University. Professor of Mathematical Statistics, University of Adelaide, 1965–89.
- James, Geoffrey S. (1924–). Lecturer in Statistics, University of Leeds, 1952–80.
- Jeffreys, Sir Harold, FRS (1891–1989). Reader in Geophysics, 1931–46, and Plumian Professor of Astronomy and Experimental Philosophy, 1946–58, University of Cambridge. Author of *Scientific inference* (1931), etc.
- Jordan, Charles (1871–1959). Professor in the Faculty of Political Economy, University of Budapest, 1933–40. Author of *The calculus of finite differences* (1939), etc.

- Kendall, Sir Maurice G., FBA (1907–83). Statistician, Chamber of Shipping, 1941–9. Professor of Statistics, University of London, 1949–61. Author of *The advanced theory of statistics* (1943), etc.
- Keyfitz, Nathan (1913–). Statistician, Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Ottawa, 1936–59. Professor of Sociology and Demography, Harvard University, 1972–80. Author of *Applied mathematical demography* (1977), etc.

- Mather, Sir Kenneth, FRS (1911–90). Lecturer, Galton Laboratory, 1934–7. Head, Genetics Department, John Innes Horticultural Institution, 1938–48. Professor of Genetics, University of Birmingham, 1948–65. Vice-chancellor, University of Southampton, 1965–71. Author of *Statistical analysis in biology* (1943), etc. Co-author with Fisher of CP 145, 146, 192, and 196.
- Michie, Donald (1923–). Research Associate, University of London, 1952–8. Professor of Machine Intelligence, University of Edinburgh, 1967–84. Author of *On machine intelligence* (1974), etc.
- Needham, Joseph, FRS, FBA (1900–). Biochemist and historian of science. Master of Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge, 1966–76. Author of *Science and civilization in China* (1954), etc.

- Prescott, James A., FRS (1890–1987). Professor of Agricultural Chemistry, 1924–55, and Director, 1938–55, Waite Agricultural Research Institute, University of Adelaide.
- Quenouille, Maurice H. (1924–73). Research Fellow, Institute of Statistics, University of Oxford, 1953–5. Professor of Statistics, University of Southampton, 1966–73. Author of *The design and analysis of experiment* (1953), etc.
- Rao, C. Radhakrishna, FRS (1920–). Professor, 1949–83, Director and Secretary, 1972–6, Indian Statistical Institute. Author of *Linear statistical inference and its application* (1973), etc.

- Smith, Hugh Fairfield (1904-74). Research worker in the Galton Laboratory and at Rothamsted, 1935-7. Professor of Statistics, University of North Carolina, Raleigh, 1950-7, and University of Connecticut, Storrs, 1965-74.
- Snedecor, George W. (1881-1974). Director of Statistical Laboratory, Iowa State College, 1933-47. Author of *Statistical methods applied to experiments in agriculture and biology* (1937).
- Spratt, David A. (1930-). Associate Professor and then Professor of Statistics, University of Waterloo, Canada, 1958-.
- Summerby, Robert F. (1886-1946). Canadian research worker at Rothamsted, 1931. Professor of Agronomy, McGill University, 1919-46.
- Thom, Herbert C.S. (1910-). Statistician in the Weather Bureau, US Department of Commerce, Washington, 1941.
- Thorpe, William H., FRS (1902-85). Lecturer in Entomology, 1932-59, and Professor of Animal Ethology, 1966-9, University of Cambridge. Author of *Science, man and morals* (1956), etc.
- Tippett, Leonard H.C. (1902-85). Research worker at Rothamsted, 1927. Statistician, British Cotton Industries Association, 1924-65. A Vice-president of the Royal Statistical Society during Fisher's Presidency, 1952-4. Author of *The methods of statistics* (1931), etc. Co-author with Fisher of CP 63.
- Tukey, John W. (1915-). Professor of Mathematics and then Professor of Statistics, Princeton University, 1950-. Author of *Exploratory data analysis* (1977), etc.
- Villars, Donald S. (1900-). Physical chemist, US Rubber General Laboratories, 1938-46, and US Naval Ordnance Test Station/Naval Weapons Centre, 1948-70. Author of *Statistical design and analysis of experiments for development research* (1951).
- Walker, Sir Gilbert T., FRS (1868-1958). Professor of Meteorology, Imperial College, London, 1924-34. Author of *Aberration* (etc).
