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

Editorial comment in British Medical Journal, 9th July, 1960 on

"Report on Confidential Enquiries into Maternal Deaths in England and Wales. 1955 - 57."

H.M.S.O. London 1960.

"Rupture of the uterus killed more women (33) than did anaesthesia (31). There is a tendency to regard this accident as a thing of the past and it is salutary to see a special section of the report devoted to it. For every fatal case of ruptured uterus there must be many non-fatal ones."

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
