ABSTRAC'I

Extensive stratigraphic thinning of the Inman Hill Formation in the Talisker mine axea has produced a weakness in an otherwise very resistant formation This weakness has resulted in a local assymetry of structure, which has had a strong influence on the localisation of the lead-arsenic ore bearing solutions.
