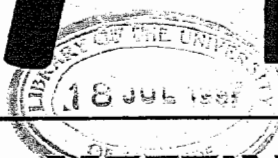

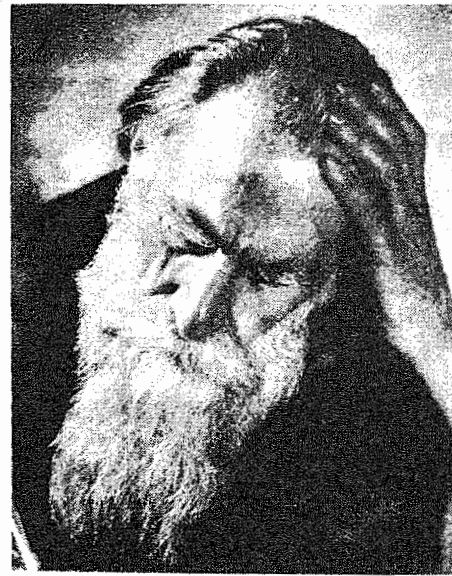

Policy: Small-L Liberal; Revised voting system for Faculty reps.



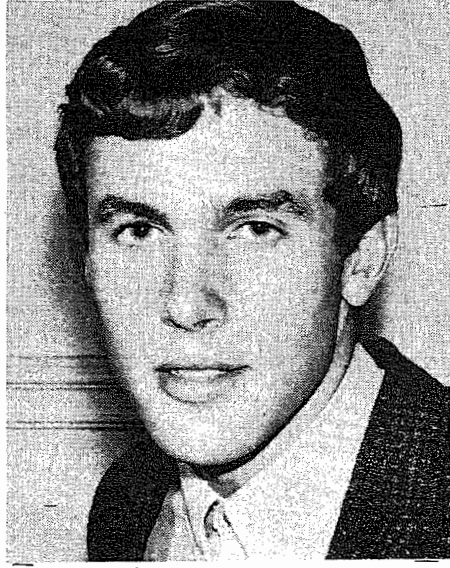

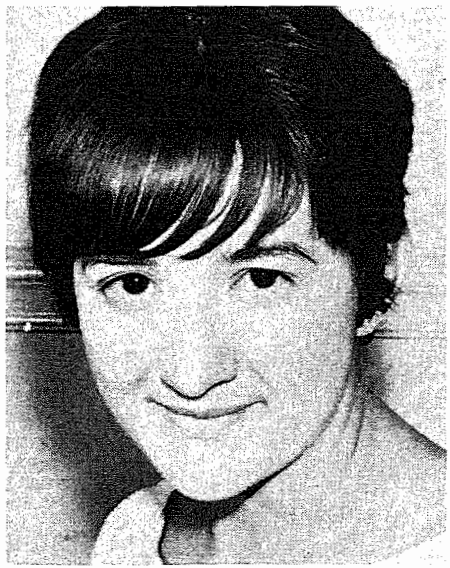
