well as to rectify a serious financial error of the past, it would be well that the £18,520 which without warrant was taken for building purposes from the Endowment Fund, should be restored to that account. This operation, however, will leave a considerable income available just in the same way as that in which a man who pays off the mortgage on his house is enabled to devote to some other purpose the money which formerly went for annual interest. Similarly the grant for music will render available all the fees for musical classes and examinations. These amounted last year to £56° and have recently town, from year to year, virtually [ the means of maintaining a Chair which had at first only a temporary endowment for five years. The fees can in future be applied to such very desirable objects as the direct encouragement of students by means of scholarships and exhibitions. In the arts and science courses there are five evening scholarships intended for those who are obliged to earn their own living. The strain of working all day and studying hard at night is very severe, being, in fact, dangerous to health, and the University authorities will no doubt take the opportunity of increasing the amounts offered so as to render it possible with economy for students to maintain themselves on them. By the Act of Incorporation the University is entitled to

an annual grant of 5 per cent. on all its endowments, and compliance with this provision in respect of the Elder bequests will still further increase the incoma of the institution, which in its strengthened position will come much nearer than heretofore to the ideal of

offering to all, whether rich or poor, the

advantages of a really liberal education.
