A delightful surprise awaits the management of these various institutions and charitable bodies, who have been kept completely in the dark as to the benevolent intentions of the largehearted donor. To crown all a sum of £25,000 has been set apart to found Workmen's Homes. Whether the will gives any indication as to the manner in which this grant is to be spent we have no means of knowing, but of the value of the gift and of the useful purpose which the disbursement of the money will serve there can be no manner of doubt. Sir Thomas has by these splendid bequests enormously increased his claims upon the lasting gratitude of South Australians, and has set a noble example of the way in which great wealth can be worthily utilized.
