JUNIOR PUBLIC EXAMINATION.

The senior and junior lists are exceedingly satisfactory to us. In the former we have only one failure, and that explained by illness. Four are in the first class, four in the second, four in the third, and one in the fourth. Churchward leads the special lists in Greek, and he is bracketed with Jolly for the top place in Latin, Basedow heads that in German, and Churchward the chemistry and physics. In the junior we have three first classes, four seconds, six thirds, and three other passes. Ward leads the English list, Priest the German, and Burnard the mathematics. To sum up on the special lists we compete in ten subjects; on eight of them we have the first place, and on the other two the second.
