SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS.

"Gold Medallist" writes:—"In reading through the reports by various masters I note that there has been an outcry in some quarters against public examinations. Where this cry has been most noticeable is where results have been poor. Masters who had the courage of their opinions found it after the records of passes were published, as their candidates sat for the ordeal. No one ever pretended that the object of exams is other than to test the knowledge of a student in certain subjects; and this they undoubtedly do. When a student has been carefully prepared, and shown the work so as to comprehend it, he is in nine cases out of ten successful. The exams present an object for the aims of the student, supply him with the needful impulse to healthy exertion, and stimulate him to laudable rivalry with his fellows. Mention was made of 'twicers.' What about those who fail, and try again—twicers, threicers, fouricers, fiveicers? If a boy did well one year, I see no reason why he should not try again to beat his own record. In one breath exams are inveighed against; in the next, whatever success was attained in them is bruted abroad with no uncertain sound."

POT-HUNTERS AT EXAMINATIONS.

The head masters of both St. Peter's and Prince Alfred Colleges, in their recent annual reports, referred to the practice which is becoming common now of students going up for the senior and junior examinations in connection with the University several times with the apparent hope of winning the money prizes offered to the three entrants who are placed highest on each of the lists. There was also a protest against candidates over age being allowed to sit for the same examination as school boys and girls, because the presence of the elders led the officials marking the papers to allot marks on a higher standard than would otherwise be the case. The chief grievance, however, was in respect to the pot-hunters, or the "twicers," as one of the head masters called them. Evidently the latter subject has been attracting attention in Melbourne also, for the Argus states that the complaint that some Melbourne secondary schools make a practice of sending up for the matriculation examination pupils who have previously passed, in order to swell the list of passes, is to be brought under the notice of the University Council to-day, when Dr. Leeper will move "that the registrar be instructed in publishing the results of the recent matriculation examination to differentiate between those candidates who pass for the first time in the December examination, 1904, and those who have previously passed and have now presented themselves again." The Adelaide University, in publishing the lists of those who succeed at the examination sets a mark against those candidates who are over age, but no action similar to that suggested by Dr. Leeper in Melbourne has ever been proposed here. Sometimes scholarships at the various colleges depend upon the amount of success a boy or girl may win at the junior, senior, or higher public examination, and in that case the candidate who has passed in one year may try again with the object of getting nearer the top of the list.
