PRODUCTION NOTE

Peter Weiss, well-known for his play MARAT/SADE, has emerged as one of the most remarkable of the post-war generation of German writers. MR. MOCKINPOTT is a play concerned with the plight of the ordinary man. It takes a satirical and often very funny look at Mockinpott's struggle against a bureaucratic and oppressive society in his search for a cure to his sufferings.

The aim of this production is to provide the students with a working opportunity to test and develop the knowledge, concepts and practical skills they have gained in the study of Drama. The project is specifically scheduled to take place early in the academic year so that students can carry a firsthand experience of theatre production with them through their subsequent work in Drama I.

Drama is essentially a practical art and a production of this nature gives students an introduction to that art as part of their formal coursework. Four weeks of intensive preparation during the University holidays have gone into rehearsing, building sets, making costumes and props, composing and arranging original music and choreography, preparing sound tapes, and organizing publicity - overall, giving students of Drama a chance to discover the essence of theatre in an act of theatre.
