

## "The Sleeping Princess"

It is, unfortunately, many years since The Firm has presented a Pantomime. However, this Christmas, at His Majesty's Theatre, Melbourne, the Borovansky Ballet Company will stage something veering in that direction. This will be the first Australian production of the full length ballet, in five scenes "The Sleeping Princess" (originally known as "The Sleeping Beauty" and the same story as that of the popular "Sleeping Beauty" pantomimes). Danced to some of the loveliest music ever composed by Tschaikovsky, "The Sleeping Princess" has many features of a pantomime—large ensembles, bright scenes and a childrens' ballet and one of the five scenes in the favourite ballet, "Aurora's Wedding." It is hoped to send the Borovansky Co. to Perth after it returns from N.Z. next year, so a Return Season in Adelaide is a possibility.
