THE CONSERVATORIUM.

The students' concert held at the Conservatorium last night was well attended, and those present evinced decided appreciation at the excellent programme presented. The list of items was well balanced, instrumental numbers relieving the vocal efforts. Miss Gladys Polglase rendered "Rebecca's Prayer" from Sullivan's opera, "Ivanhoe." It is interesting to note that more than a little attention has been given to this work by students lately. Miss Annie Gibbie was heard in Handel's "Sleep, Why Doest Thou Leave Me?" and Miss Winifred Howard essayed the recit and aria, "Now at last comes the moment" and "O, come do not delay," from Mozart's "Marriage of Figaro." Beethoven's "Creation's Hymn" was the item vocalised by Miss Gladys Prosser. Two of Sanderson's songs, "Bird Lullaby" and "Shepherd's Dance," were sung by Miss Valeria Williams. Miss Mabel Halliday pleasingly rendered a bracket of songs, "Blanche et Rose" (Delibes), "Aubade" (Lalo), and "Through the Garden Steals a Perfume" (Shapleigh). Schubert's "The Wanderer" was Miss Florence Rowe's contribution. Mr. John Ardill sang "My Queen" (Bibmenthal). Pianoforte solos were played by Miss Dorothy McBride (Mozakowski's scherzo valse, op 40) and Miss Lillian Barbour (Hassler's Gigue in D minor). Miss Erica Chaplin selected as her violin solo the adagio movement from Spohr's Ninth Concerto. Miss Eyleen Page also contributed a violin item, Sorensen's "Romance." The violoncello solos "Sarabande" (Handel) and "Tarantella" (Squire) were rendered by Mr. Edwin Neske. Mr. Harold Parsons assisted by playing the violoncello part in the trio in D major (Beethoven). The pianoforte score was contributed by Miss Evelyn Stokes, and Miss E. Chaplin attended to the violin part.

AMUSEMENTS.

There was a large attendance at the Elder Hall on Monday evening, when a concert by students at the Elder Conservatorium was given. Miss Lillian Barbour opened the programme with the pianoforte solo, "Gigue in D minor" (Hassler), which she treated in pleasing style. Blumental's song, "My Queen," was sympathetically sung by Mr. John Ardill. Miss Eileen Page displayed creditable taste and technique in her violin solo, "Romance" (Svensden). In "Rebecca's Prayer," from "Ivanhoe" (Sullivan), Miss Gladys Poiglaise sang with good taste and feeling, both in the recitative, "O, awful depth below the castle well," and in the effective aria, "Lord of our chosen race." A Handel number, "O sleep, why dost thou leave me?" gave Miss Annie Gibbie an opportunity for appropriate vocalisation of which she fully availed herself. The always difficult instrument, the violoncello, was carefully handled by Mr. Edwin Noske in his bracket of "Sarabande" (Handel) and the more sparkling "Tarantella" (Squire). Miss Valeria Williams won deserved applause by her dainty singing of "Bird Lullaby" and "Shepherd's Dance" (Sanderson). Careful training and artistic insight were evident in the interpretation given by Miss Winifred Howard of the recitative and aria, "Guisne al fin il momento" and "Deh vieni non tardar" (Mozart). Miss Dorothy McBride showed decided talent in her pianoforte reading of "Scherzo Valse," opus 40 (Moszkowski), well-developed technique and artistic temperament being united in a satisfactory rendering of the item. "Creation Hymn" (Beethoven) was admirably sung by Miss Gladys Prosser. Miss Erica Chaplin (Elder scholar) gave a fine interpretation of Spohr's difficult violin writing in the "Adagio" movement from the ninth concerto. A pretty group of songs, "Blanche et Rose" (Delibes), "Aubade" (Lalo), and "Through the garden steals a perfume" (Shapleigh), was nicely presented by Miss Mabel Halliday. Miss Florence Rowe was heard to advantage in Schubert's dramatic song, "The Wanderer." In the final number the first movement of "Trio in D major," opus 70, for pianoforte, violin, and violoncello, Miss Eveline Stokes (piano) and Miss Erica Chaplin (violin) were assisted by Mr. Harold Parsons, Mus. Bac. (violoncello). The production was very effective, and the applause which followed was thoroughly well earned.
