THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES.

GATHERING IN THE TOWN HALL.

There was a large and distinguished gathering in the Town Hall at 5 o'clock on Saturday afternoon, when a special congregation of the University of Adelaide was held for the purpose of doing honor to some of the principal visitors by conferring degrees upon them. The universities of Melbourne, Sydney, and Adelaide came to an understanding in the matter of what degrees were to be awarded, because Sydney and Adelaide are restricted to admission "Ad eundem gradum," and Sydney by its charter is unable to recognise any but British degrees, while Melbourne is in a position to confer any degree upon any graduate. It was agreed that degrees would be conferred only on the general officers of the association, presidents of sections, authors of evening addresses, and representative visitors from the British Dominions and foreign countries. This list was divided between Adelaide and Melbourne, while Sydney will take a larger share of the British graduates.

The scene in the Town Hall was one of the most brilliant and impressive ever witnessed there. All round the hall were hung Union Jacks and Commonwealth flags, and there was an abundant display of Australia's national emblem—the wattle. The platform was decorated with ferns and other foliage, and on the wall to the right of it were hung life-size portraits of their Majesties King George and Queen Mary, which were recently presented by the King to Government House. The handsome academic robes, rich in color, worn by the graduates, lent additional splendor to the scene.

At 4.50 p.m. the Chancellor of the University (his Honor Sir Samuel Way, P.C.) entered the hall, accompanied by the vice-chancellor (Dr. Barlow, C.M.G.), members of the council, the warden (Mr. F. Chapple, B.A., B.Sc.), the clerk of the Senate (Mr. T. A. Caterer), the registrar (Mr. C. R. Hodge), the Commissioner of Public Works (Sir Richard Butler), Sir Oliver Lodge (president of the British Association), Professor Bateson (president-elect), Sir Langdon Bonython (president of the South Australian School of Mines and Industries), Professor Stirling (president of the South Australian committee of the British Association), the Mayor of Adelaide (Mr. A. A. Simpson), and the town clerk (Mr. T. G. Ellery).
