Dear Fisher,

Many thanks for your letter. Pearson had already reacted to me directly. I enclose his letter and a copy of my reply, which was written before I got your letter, unfortunately. I hope I have not been toomild.

The Ministry have not so far asked me to join the Crop Weather Committee, though they have appointed Rothamsted to remain in charge of the statistics of the Sampling Wheat Observations. I redrafted the instructions, as I told you. There was some hurry about setting them out and I consequently could not submit them to you as you were in Scotland at the time. I am now enclosing a copy, however, and should be very glad of any criticisms and suggestions. I also send a copy of the third quarterly report.

I have now got a general expression for the probability any particular set of observations in a 2 x 2 contingency

table, and am making a survey to see what are the limits for the application of χ^2 . I will send you the results as soon as there is anything worth looking at.
