Dear Dr. Connell,

Thanks for your letter giving me your information about the proportion of A to 0 in two reciprocal types of family. I am not personally at 11 everse from believing that such selection occurs though it requires very thorough evidence to substantiate it. If attempted also it would require the discovery of some mechanism of counter selection capable of maintaining the pro-ortion of A in the population. I should be inclined, a priori to expect that all these things will be found in time, and your research is, therefore, certainly a step in the right direction, though I should feel a good deal happier if it had been possible to enumerate complete families.

I expect you are in a position to sub-divide each group of children between the two sexes. More than one piece of research has been suggestive of disturbed sex ratios.
