Dear Sir Ronald,

You may remember as a result of our conversation at the Guinness expedition taking up with Dr. Healy the question of Glaxo Laboratories supporting the computation of tables relevant to Behren's problem from (1,1) to (7,7) degrees of freedom.

These computations were completed, as you forecast in your letter to Mr. Dunn of 28th March, 1956, by the end of April, and my colleagues and I are now about to publish the experimental work for which these tables were computed.

We would like to give an appropriate reference for the extended tables and would appreciate your advice as to whether you or your publishers would have any objection to our mentioning their impending appearance in the next issue of Statistical Tables. Alternatively, you may be intending to publish a paper on the derivation of the explicit formulae involved to which you would prefer us to refer. In the latter event we should be happy to do so if you will let me know the appropriate reference.

In conclusion I would like to thank you for your help and good offices in getting these tables computed and thereby easing considerably the interpretation of our results.
