My dear Fisher,

When I was living in Happonen, I used to make fairly full and careful counts of all colonies within a square area of 6 square miles, including the Urban District of Harjavalta. This I did for 10 or 12 years, but at rather diverted later to the more difficult job of tracing the course of flocks and their minor affluents on the way to their roost in winter. I imagine the book of my results is still at home and not long since sent to me here yet. I remember the total number was surprisingly constant in view of the considerable changes involving the origination and extirpation of the colonies.

I am sure I could dig it out and let you judge if there is anything of value, if discreetly passed on from time to time.

I think the observation of ~~weaklight~~ was that on one occasion in the winter flight at Camp Moree which had certainly not contained a rookery for many years was followed in the following year by nest-building in the same. I wish I had been in touch with some other rook fan at the time.
