Dear Ford,

I should be delighted if you will come here any day next week which will suit you - and still more so if you could, as we both hoped earlier in the year, make another visit on Saturday or Sunday week to see at least the wreckage of my poultry experiment. The succession of deaths has been appalling, and I am scarcely anywhere better off than I was this time last year. I shall almost certainly be forced to apply to the Royal to subsidise the experiment for the eighth year, 1937, which I am really very reluctant to do. There are some interesting points worth discussing as to the best use which can now be made of the available material.
