I cannot understand what is happening to the journal of Genetics. When Punnett was Editor he published scores of papers from my laboratory. Well over a year ago I sent Haldane a paper on the genetics of wild cabbages based on work done thirty years ago. He agreed to publish it if I deleted certain portions which I did. But I have been unable to get any further reply from him. Is he trying to punish me for not being a Communist? I have about six other papers in press at the moment, ranging from a big monograph on *Oenothera* to an anthropological paper on skin colour, but none has been delayed in this way.
