Dear Gates,

Thanks for your note. I am sure that a large factor in the supposed absence of segregation in the effspring of mulattos is the mere inaccuracy in the estimation of variance from small samples. The F<sub>2</sub> warrance should, in fact, be greater than that in F<sub>4</sub> only by the addition of an interracial component, since both will include all intraracial variance with errors of measurement,

and it would need fairly considerable samples of homogeneous material to detect the additional variability.
