Thanks for your letter. I suspect you have the notes offprints by now, as I was able to find them.

As you know I think Lyoff's variation went off the scale on the small sample problem, but so far as I have seen, his large sample (X') method was right. I have not seen other criticisms of my method. Nor do I know what "assumptions" have been suggested. My approach was concerned analogous to Gauss' analysis based on the Normal distribution, which will give correct results even when the distribution is not exact.
