Dear Jeffreys,

Haldane is now at Rothamsted. I showed him your paper, and enclose his remarks.

I imagine your point is not so much that the particular problem of the negative binomial is more easily solved using your modified X² than in other ways, but that, in examining any body of data, discrepancies will appear suggesting a more elaborate formulation involving new parameters, in which modified X² may be a good deal quicker than maximum likelihood.
