Many thanks for your letter and for letting me see the tables of relationship before they are published. I certainly think they ought to do a great deal of good in emphasising the importance of the hereditary element, in a wide class of social disabilities.

I shall be much interested to see the report when it comes out. I scarcely expected to see good 3 : 1 ratios, but the extent to which your ratios fall short of 25 per cent. may I should think be taken as a measure of the dilution of simply genetic cases, <sup>by</sup> ~~but~~ either non-congenital or genetic cases of a more complicated nature.
