Dear Provost,

If your intention was to charge Miss Simpson's salary to the £500 made available on our agreement before the Chairman on the 7th October, 1939, I must point out that this would be contrary to the agreement, as at that time you most explicitly assured me that "the one member of your present staff" referred to under vi (a) was to be, in the first instance, Munday, and on his calling up, which you expected would occur in May 1940, would be Miss North, now Mrs Holt. Miss Simpson was at no stage suggested as the one whose salary would be paid out of this fund.

I am afraid I cannot agree to this alteration in the terms of our agreement.

I should like, without delay, to nominate Olbrycht for one of the free places you mention, provided it is clear that he thereby does not become liable for fees or any other payments to the College.
