Dear Professor Nachtsheim,

I have been in touch with Rhesus work in this country from its inception, and indeed was responsible for getting together the Galton Laboratory Serum Unit, which has been the centre of this work. Now Race and Mourant are established at the Lister Institute, but I am still closely in touch with their work.

I do not know what you mean by my work published last year, unless possibly you refer to a lecture given at Yale in that year, in which I summarise briefly the course of progress at the Serum Unit referred to. I enclose a copy of this lecture.

I am very much obliged for your offprints, and as you mention the Rh factor, perhaps you could let me know whether you have published anything on this subject.

I am sending also a few pieces of genetical work from recent years.
