My Dear Professor,


I am sending you a review of Harland's book on Cotton Genetics for the Annals. With the situation so rapidly changing, it is difficult to imagine what the conditions would be when this letter reaches you ; but we here earnestly hope that you would be able to carry on your work and continue to give your guidance to research workers.

I have laid out a trial with 31 cotton varieties in incomplete blocks to study a discriminant function for selection for yield. I am growing fresh F_2 s of the crosses I have been working on and also propose to make new crosses between more widely differing types.

You must have received my letter of 1st. June. I understand that Dr. P. V. Sukhatme has been selected for the Delhi post.
