Dear Peters,

I am sending you herewith 6 papers involving comparisons with copper and nicotine sulphate, which the A.R.C. sent on to me. I believe you are doing the bibliographical part, but Miss Burton has made abstracts of these papers, of which I enclose copies to use as you think fit. It is curious that Lyle Stewart and Crofton (1941) mention Moniezia and Nematodirus as better dealt with by copper nicotine sulphates than by Phenothiazine. This is based on change of egg count after four and eight weeks. He seems to be able to count Moniezia eggs.
