Dear Riddell,

Here is a list of 39 colour classes with more than two members, done as before. The sex difference is now 14.427 years for the whole 1000 cases.

On the second sheet I have set out the 10 commonest classes, as these deserve rather special consideration, and the tables below are meant to show such evidence as there is for the colour of spots changing with time, i.e., in five cases out of six chocolate spots are older than tan spots; on four comparisons tan spots are older than yellow spots, and only one comparison - and that a bad one - yellow spots are older than green spots, whatever these latter may be. The columns of mean ages are headed with the mean ages of men and women and the mean score respectively.
