In consideration of the payment of 1000 roubles of internal currency, I, Dr. R.A. Fisher of Galton Laboratory, Gower Street, London, W.C.1, England, hereby grant to the State Publishing House of Biological and Medical Literature of Moscow, U.S.S.R., the exclusive right to publish a Russian translation of the first seven chapters of my book, The Genetical Theory of Natural Selection, published by the Clarendon Press, Oxford, 1930, subject to the conditions following:-

- (1) I reserve the right to permit translations into other languages or to grant other subsidiary rights.
- (2) A set of the proofs of the translation shall be submitted to me for my approval, and no modification or additions shall be published without my approval.
- (3) Any new matter or alterations supplied by me and incorporated into the Russian edition shall be available for inclusion in any future English edition of the work.
- (4) Two presentation copies of the Russian translation shall be sent to me on publication.
