Dear Dr Wiener,

Many thanks for sending me your offprints on the Rhesus factor, some of which I had not seen before, though I had in broad outline followed your work. At the moment I find the evidence very convincing that there not one but three antibodies reacting with the so-called Rhesus-negative gene. I am wondering whether it should be taken as axiomatic that there is only one anti-O antibody. It seems to me that there really is room for two.
