Mingari were all women, no mama, they sat down at Kallangaba. They sat down allinjarra because Nyiruna who was Burnburnbulala, came and frightened them. He went underneath the ground and heard them gumbuna (urinating) and wanted them for his guri (wives).

Then dogs, bulgu, heard Nyiruna, but Nyiruna caught Mingari and then they fought with Nyiruna's dogs. Mingari sat down at their own kaangga and their dogs kept Nyiruna. Then he chased them allinjerra and they sat down at Anmunga where they now are. All the baby mingari are there - no mama - mingari dhugurr. Nyugaling was Nyiruna's dog.
