Native foods in district?

Beloo (seeds), moorin (seeds), windailga, mooga (kurrajong seeds), daaroon (like potato), garre (gum), yoogo (root of kurrajong).

When kurrajong seeds are first eaten, blood comes, but then the seed knows the eater.
