My postcard of the Northam woman was that of Mung'an'yup, alias Jinny Shaw, a Northam Tondarup. She was Kajaman's "jookamat" or donmala, her mother being Kajaman's mother's kowat (youngest sister). Munganyup was my ngangamat and was a Tondarup.

Winditch, alias Kungytch, a Ballarruk married Moolyel, a Didarruk and had issue

Aram, male, a Didarruk Mingeran, female " Injeran 33 Kajaman and two other boys who died young.

Also Nemma, a Tondarup, who had issue

Wemmagan, female, a Tondarup Yinel (alias Tommy Winditch)

Aram, male, a Didarruk married Bandardan, a Ballarruk No issue.

Mingeran, female, Didarruk married Walbytch (an Albany native), a Ballarruk No issue

Injeran, female, Didarruk married Jinbur, a Ballarruk and had issue Nyangil, male, Didarruk

Kajaman, female, Didarruk married Kog-err, a Ballarruk (betrothed in infancy)

also Jendil, a Tondarup (moojoo marriage)

and had issue Binjil, male, Didarruk Jig'eran, female Nwanel, male Woodel, male Ngamil, male 19 93 Beerungan, female Nyineran

Kajaman's mother's pediaree

Koobert, male, a Ballarruk married Binyin, female, Didarruk and had issue Moolyel, female, a Didarruk (Kajaman's mother) Wel'aban Darjin, male

Winditch (Tommy Winditch's father), alias Kungytch, the name Kungytch was given him because he got into a big hollow in a warnda tree after opessums and couldn't get out - koonga boorna (hollow wood) kungytch. Moolwel's totem ("borungur") was the boodee "Moolyung" a boodee hole.

Kajaman's oobar is Tamar. Her name was given her from something in connection with the tamar; the father usually gives the name, or the grandfather.

Kajaman (Polly Jindil) is a Didarruk. Her husband was a Tondarup. (moojoo marriage).
She is my ngangamat and Arnold's demmamat.

Her daughter is jooka - "kooperding", "kowat" or "koolingurt" (all three names for youngest sister) to me.

Louis's children are my nobab - also my moyermum (the boys call me "mungart" = these children are half brothers and sisters, donmala, to Arnold who is a Tondarup.
